

## Kingwood Municipal Court Annex Ribbon Cutting

Council Member Sullivan held a ribbon cutting ceremony marking the reopening of the newly renovated Kingwood Municipal Court Annex (Court #22) on Wednesday, November 24. The expansion of the court room was completed and was available for defendants last month. The expansion allows for the Municipal Courts to run the Kingwood court as a fully operating court room. Along with extension of the court hours, this annex court has fulfilled what Council Member Sullivan envisioned for the Kingwood community. With the enlarged space, the Municipal Court Department will be better equipped to see defendants and ensure that they are fully serviced.
